## Signs and symbols

**III<sup>4</sup>** = bar on the third fret comprising the first four strings

**[I]** = bar on adjacent strings with the point of the first finger

**LIV** = lifted bar on the fourth fret

**3<sup>4</sup>** = changing the third finger by the fourth on a string without stopping the sound

(The dotted slurs in the guitar part correspond to ordinary slurs in the original piano part)
